It has been put together to ensure that the Sixth Form is purposeful, enjoyable and successful within the whole school community.

Both you and your parents/carers are expected to sign it and keep a copy.

What will Hazelbeck School try to do?

- Provide appropriate support, supervision, guidance, teaching and assessment within the resources we have available
- Offer you the most appropriate activities to meet your needs and interests, including access to Further Education provision and work experience
- Offer you sports, physical activities and enhancements to the curriculum to extend your experiences
- Support your health and well-being
- Help you prepare for life after school
- Give you opportunities to discuss anything causing you concern
- Maintain communication with your parents/carers.

What will the student do with the support of their Parents/Carers?

- Come to school every day, unless unwell or working somewhere else
- Not take holidays during term time
- Join in, contribute to and work hard in all chosen Sixth Form modules
- Make sure appearance is appropriate in school and at school events
- Not smoke, drink alcohol or handle drugs in or near school, or during any school events or visits
- Be considerate and respectful towards everyone and their property
- Behave well and not use bad language towards others.

As a Sixth Form student, you are expected to take appropriate responsibility for what you do.
