<p>Hazelbeck School will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide a balanced curriculum that meets the needs of each student • Ensure that the student is given the opportunity to make outstanding progress • Provide an Annual Report • Provide opportunities for parents/carers to discuss the progress of the student • Deal with any cases of bullying or harassment firmly and in a manner appropriate to the situation • Provide information via the website • Contact the family in the event of an accident or any problem • Encourage all students to take responsibility for their behaviour • Reward achievement and effort • Encourage all students to have respect for themselves, their surroundings and property • Maintain a partnership with parents by keeping in regular contact. • Use Team Teach in order to keep everyone safe 	<p>Students will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Come to school every day and on time • Wear school uniform and be clean and tidy • Respect other people's property • Bring all equipment in a bag including PE kit • Tell an adult if anyone is upset or bullied • Behave in a polite, respectful, sensible and safe way to all adults and students • Respect the rights of others • Take care of the school environment and all property • Respect all staff and respond promptly to all reasonable requests • Move around school sensibly • Work hard at all times. 	<p>Parents/Carers will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attend parent/carer meetings, reviews and discussions about child's progress • Inform school of change of name, address and telephone number • Read letters and notices from school and respond if necessary • Ensure their child comes to school regularly and inform the school on the first morning of absence if they cannot attend • Not take family holidays during term time • Let the school know of any problems that might affect their child's work or behaviour • Encourage their child to be well behaved and to respect all staff and other students • Be positive and supportive of their child's efforts at school • Ensure that their child: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Wears school uniform * Does not bring any harmful substance to school * Switches their mobile phone off during school hours
