



SEND Short Breaks - Specialist Inclusion Day Trips

Here at SEND Short Breaks and Specialist Inclusion, we are running 5-day trips during the February holidays for our children and young people. Day trips will **not** be running on a 1:1 staff ratio – they are for children and young people who are able to participate in a social activity on a 1:3 staff ratio.

The day trips are fully funded by us, transport is an option, they are **not** family events (young people will attend without parent/carers), and all enquiries from families must be made **via my email address** – halima.kara2@bradford.gov.uk

Your young person will be supported by the full staff team at Specialist Inclusion, including myself, coordinators, and casual support workers.

Our criteria are as follows:

- Children and young people aged 8 18 years
- Children with SEND, evidenced in an EHCP
- Children who are **not** open to Bradford Children's Social Care, i.e. do not have an allocated social worker, or any other package of care through a social care team.

If you are interested in our day trips, please email your interest/enquiry with your child's full name, DOB and your address. I will ensure our criteria is met, and you will then receive information and booking forms from a member of my team. Spaces run on a first-come-first-served basis, and a booking is only secure once you have received a confirmation email/letter.

We have 5 days of trips – young people are only able to book onto one day (if you would like more than one day, please let me know and should we have space, I will offer an additional day).

Monday 17th February – Friday 21st February 2025:

Each day will host similar activities (depending on level of need).

Pick up at Asda Keighley at 8:50am. (Buckden House minibus). Minibus will leave Asda at 9am prompt. Travel to Buckden House.

- Offsite activities including Caving / Gill Scramble depending on weather
- Afternoon activities onsite including Climbing, Archery, and Abseiling. (Full change of clothes will be required wellies and waterproofs provided by Buckden).

Travel back to Asda Keighley – arrive by 5pm.

All young people attending would need to bring a packed lunch for each day (lunch not provided) and a change of clothes. Further information provided in booking form.
